- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17
- MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 18

- 21 The ANY APPLICABLE fees specified in this part for a certificate of title shall
- 22be paid to the Administration before issuance of the certificate.

1	(a)	Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section and § 13-805 of this
2	subtitle, the	fee for each certificate of title issued under this title is \$100.

- 3 (b) **(1)** For fiscal years 2012 through 2014 only, the fee for each certificate 4 of title issued for a rental vehicle is \$50.
- 5 (2) ON THE DEATH OF A JOINT OWNER OF A VEHICLE, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CHARGE A FEE FOR A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE 7 ISSUED TO THE OTHER JOINT OWNER.
- 8 13–805.
- For the issuance of a duplicate certificate of title, issued under § 13–111 of this title to replace a lost, stolen, or damaged certificate of title, the fee shall be established by the Administration.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
