### Agriculture – Commercial Feed – Arsenic Prohibition

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from using, selling, or distributing certain
commercial feed that contains roxarsone or any other additive that contains
arsenic; providing for the termination of this Act under certain circumstances;
requiring the State Department of Agriculture to provide a certain notification;
providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the contents of
commercial feed.

## 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Part 514, if the U.S. Food and Drug Administration: 9 approves the use of Roxarsone. or any other additive that contains 10 (1)11 arsenic: and 12<del>(2)</del> finds that the exposure to Roxarsone. or any other additive that 13 <del>contains arsenic is:</del> 14 unavoidable and necessary: and <del>(i)</del>

- 16 (1) <u>approves the use of the arsenical additive; and</u>
- 17 (2) <u>includes in its approval an evaluation of:</u>
- 18 <u>(i) human food safety:</u>
- 19 <u>(ii)</u> <u>impact on the environment;</u>
- 20 <u>(iii)</u> <u>safety to animals;</u>
- 21 (iv) effectiveness of the drug for its intended use; and
- 22 (v) <u>chemistry and manufacturing procedures.</u>

(b) The State Department of Agriculture shall notify the Department of
 Legislative Services within 5 days after the action under subsection (a) of this section
 occurs.
