A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Task Force to Study the County and Municipal Revenue Structure

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study the County and Municipal 4 Revenue Structure; providing for the membership and duties of the Task Force; 5 providing for the designation of a chair of the Task Force; requiring the 6 Department of Legislative Services to provide staff for the Task Force; 7 prohibiting members of the Task Force from receiving compensation; 8 authorizing a member to receive certain reimbursement; requiring the Task 9 Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of 10 this Act; and generally relating to a Task Force to Study the County and 11 12Municipal Revenue Structure.
- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:
- 15 (a) There is a Task Force to Study the County and Municipal Revenue 16 Structure.
- 17 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 18 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 19 President of the Senate:
- 20 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker 21 of the House:
- 22 (3) the Comptroller of the Treasury, or the Comptroller's designee;
- 23 (4) the Secretary of Budget and Management, or the Secretary's 24 designee;

1	(g) (1) On or before November 30, 2012, the Task Force shall submit a
2	preliminary report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in
3	accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the Senate Budget and
4	Taxation Committee and the House Appropriations Committee and Committee on
5	Ways and Means.

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- (2) On or before December 31, 2012, the Task Force shall submit a final report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2012. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 11 2013, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be 12 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
