4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain officer in Caroline County, Dorchester 5 County, and Talbot County to request from the Criminal Justice Information 6 System Central Repository of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional 7 Services a State and national criminal history records check for a prospective 8 county employee or volunteer; requiring that a certain officer submit certain 9 sets of fingerprints and fees to the Central Repository as part of the application 10 for a criminal history records check; requiring the Central Repository to forward 11 to the prospective employee or volunteer and a certain officer the prospective 12 employee's or volunteer's criminal history record information under certain circumstances; establishing that information obtained from the Central 13 Repository under this Act is confidential, may not be redisseminated, and may 14 be used only for certain purposes; authorizing the subjects of a criminal history 15 records check under this Act to contest the contents of a certain printed 16 17 statement issued by the Central Repository; requiring the governing bodies of 18 Caroline County, Dorchester County, and Talbot County to adopt guidelines to 19 carry out this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to criminal 20 history records checks.
