15 16	(a) With the approval of the Commission, the Director may adopt regulations of the Agency.
17	(b) The regulations of the Agency shall provide for:
18 19	(1) all matters that are necessary or desirable for the efficient and economical operation and administration of the State lottery; [and]
20 21	(2) the convenience of buyers of State lottery tickets and shares and of the holders of a winning ticket or share; AND
