Amusement Parks - Safety Warnings

- FOR the purpose of requiring that the State Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board, in consultation with the State Traumatic Brain Injury Advisory Board, determine if it is necessary to require a certain concussion warning at amusement parks, those rides in which a certain passenger is at risk, and the appropriate method of warning passengers; requiring the State Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board to reports report its findings on or before a certain date; and generally relating to safety warnings for amusement attractions.
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (a) the State Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board, in consultation with 13 the State Traumatic Brain Injury Advisory Board, shall determine:
- 14 (1) if it is necessary to require amusement parks to warn passengers 15 of the dangers of riding amusement rides if the passenger has recently suffered a 16 concussion;
- 17 (2) those rides in which a passenger who has recently suffered a concussion is at risk; and
 - (3) the appropriate method of warning passengers; and
