# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists – Certified3Professional Counselor-Alcohol and Drug – Repeal

- 4 FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law relating to the requirements  $\mathbf{5}$ that must be met to qualify as a certified professional counselor-alcohol and 6 drug; repealing a certain requirement that the State Board of Professional 7 Counselors and Therapists grant a certain waiver to certain applicants; 8 prohibiting the Board from placing a certified professional counselor-alcohol 9 and drug on inactive status; prohibiting the Board from reinstating the certificate of a certified professional counselor-alcohol and drug under certain 10 circumstances; providing that this Act may not be construed to invalidate 11 12certain certificates or to prohibit certain renewals; and generally relating to the repeal of the certified professional counselor-alcohol and drug certificate. 13
