3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Veterans Affairs, on request, to 4 provide a veteran with a document certifying veteran status; requiring the 5 Motor Vehicle Administration to ensure that the driver's license or 6 identification card of an applicant who presents a certain certification of veteran 7 status includes a notation indicating that the applicant is a veteran; requiring 8 an application for a driver's license or an identification card to allow an 9 applicant to indicate that the applicant is a veteran and consents to being contacted by the Department for certain purposes; requiring the Administration 10 to electronically transmit certain information to the Department; authorizing 11 12the Administration to adopt regulations to carry out certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to drivers' licenses and identification cards of 13 14 veterans.
