A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Drivers' Licenses and Identification Cards – Notation of Veteran Status**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Veterans Affairs, on request, to
4 provide a veteran with a document certifying veteran status; requiring the
5 Motor Vehicle Administration to ensure that the driver's license or
6 identification card of an applicant who presents a certain certification of veteran
7 status includes a notation indicating that the applicant is a veteran; requiring
8 an application for a driver's license or an identification card to allow an
9 applicant to indicate that the applicant is a veteran and consents to being
10 contacted by the Department for certain purposes; requiring the Administration
11 to electronically transmit certain information to the Department; authorizing
12 the Administration to adopt regulations to carry out certain provisions of this
13 Act; and generally relating to drivers' licenses and identification cards of
14 veterans.

2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 **Article – State Government**

5 9–901.

6 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

7 (b) “Department” means the Department of Veterans Affairs.

8 (d) Except as otherwise provided in §§ 9–906 and 9–907 of this subtitle,
9 “veteran” means an individual who served on active duty in the armed forces of the
10 United States, other than for training, and was discharged or released under
11 conditions other than dishonorable.

12 9–905.

13 The Department shall:

14 (1) help veterans and their dependents to receive promptly and
15 regularly all of the benefits to which veterans or dependents are entitled under federal
16 law; [and]

17 (2) help veterans and their dependents in:

18 (i) preparing, in proper form, claims for benefits;

19 (ii) presenting the claims to the appropriate governmental unit;

20 (iii) trying to prevent and to relieve congestion in the processing
21 of the claims; and

22 (iv) obtaining and expediting action on the claims; AND

23 (3) ON REQUEST, PROVIDE A VETERAN WITH A DOCUMENT
24 CERTIFYING VETERAN STATUS.

27 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ENSURE THAT THE DRIVER’S LICENSE
28 OR IDENTIFICATION CARD OF AN APPLICANT WHO PRESENTS A CERTIFICATION

1 OF VETERAN STATUS OBTAINED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
2 AFFAIRS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 9-905 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE
3 INCLUDES A NOTATION INDICATING THAT THE APPLICANT IS A VETERAN.

4 (B) (1) AN APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR AN
5 IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL ALLOW AN APPLICANT TO INDICATE THAT THE
6 APPLICANT IS A VETERAN AND CONSENTS TO BEING CONTACTED BY THE
7 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS REGARDING THE APPLICANT'S
8 ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE OR FEDERAL VETERANS' BENEFITS.

9 (2) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMIT
10 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS APPROPRIATE INFORMATION
11 ABOUT EACH APPLICANT WHO CONSENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH
12 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

13 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT
14 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2012.
