- 8 (C) THE BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT ALL ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND POLICIES OF THE CENTER AND SITES ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE POLICIES OF AND APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION.
- 11 (D) THE BOARD MAY APPLY, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND ANY GIFT, 12 APPROPRIATION, OR GRANT FROM THE STATE, COUNTY, OR FEDERAL 13 GOVERNMENT OR ANY OTHER PERSON.
- 14 (E) THE BOARD MAY MAKE AGREEMENTS WITH THE FEDERAL, STATE, 15 OR A COUNTY GOVERNMENT OR ANY OTHER PERSON, IF IT CONSIDERS THE 16 AGREEMENT ADVISABLE FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CENTER.
- 17 (F) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT A CORPORATE SEAL.
- 18 (G) IN ADDITION TO OTHER REPORTS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSION, THE BOARD SHALL:
- 20 (1) KEEP RECORDS THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH SOUND 21 BUSINESS PRACTICES AND ACCOUNTING RECORDS USING GENERALLY 22 ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES;
- 23 (2) CAUSE AN AUDIT BY AN INDEPENDENT CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT TO BE MADE OF THE ACCOUNTS AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE 25 CENTER AT THE CONCLUSION OF EACH FISCAL YEAR; AND
- 26 (3) FOR ANY STATE MONEY, BE SUBJECT TO AN AUDIT BY THE 27 OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 2–1220 THROUGH 28 2–1227 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
