## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Allegany and Garrett Counties – Slot Machines for Nonprofit Organizations

- FOR the purpose of adding Allegany County and Garrett County to the list of counties
  in which certain nonprofit fraternal, religious, and war veterans' organizations
  may own and operate a certain number of slot machines under certain
  circumstances; and generally relating to slot machines in Allegany County and
  Garrett County.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
