2 (a) In each county containing productive agricultural land, the county 3 governing body shall appoint an agricultural preservation advisory board.

4 (b) (1) Except as provided in [paragraph (2)] PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) 5 of this subsection, the agricultural preservation advisory board shall consist of five 6 members, at least three of whom shall be owner-operators of commercial farms who 7 earn 50 percent or more of their income from farming.

8 (2) In Worcester County, the agricultural preservation advisory board 9 shall consist of seven members, at least four of whom shall be owner-operators of 10 commercial farms who earn 50 percent or more of their income from farming.

11 (3) IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY, THE AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION 12 ADVISORY BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF FIVE MEMBERS, AT LEAST THREE OF 13 WHOM SHALL BE ACTIVELY PURSUING THE PRODUCTION OF AGRICULTURAL 14 PRODUCTS FOR PROFIT.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 16 October 1, 2012.
