17 18 19	(b) (1) Except with the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision, a local state of emergency may not continue or be renewed for longer than [7] 30 days.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 78 October 1, 2012.

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
