	(3) (I) "COVERED ELECTRONIC DEVICE" MEANS A COMPUTER OR VIDEO DISPLAY DEVICE WITH A SCREEN THAT IS GREATER THAN 4 INCHES MEASURED DIAGONALLY.
4	(II) "COVERED ELECTRONIC DEVICE" DOES NOT INCLUDE A

- 5 VIDEO DISPLAY DEVICE THAT IS PART OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OR THAT IS
  6 CONTAINED WITHIN A HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCE OR COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL,
  7 OR MEDICAL EQUIPMENT.
- 8 (4) "R2 CERTIFIED RECYCLER" MEANS A RECYCLER OF COVERED 9 ELECTRONIC DEVICES THAT IS CERTIFIED IN THE R2 PRACTICES STANDARDS 10 THAT ARE MAINTAINED BY R2 SOLUTIONS.
- 11 (5) (I) "VIDEO DISPLAY DEVICE" MEANS AN ELECTRONIC
  12 DEVICE WITH AN OUTPUT SURFACE THAT DISPLAYS OR IS CAPABLE OF
  13 DISPLAYING MOVING GRAPHICAL IMAGES OR VISUAL REPRESENTATIONS OF
  14 IMAGE SEQUENCES OR PICTURES THAT SHOW A NUMBER OF QUICKLY
  15 CHANGING IMAGES ON A SCREEN TO CREATE THE ILLUSION OF MOTION.
- 16 (II) "VIDEO DISPLAY DEVICE" INCLUDES A DEVICE THAT IS
  17 AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE DISPLAY AND CANNOT EASILY BE REMOVED FROM
  18 THE DISPLAY BY THE CONSUMER AND THAT PRODUCES THE MOVING IMAGE ON
  19 THE SCREEN.
- 20 (III) A VIDEO DISPLAY DEVICE MAY USE A CATHODE-RAY 21 TUBE (CRT), LIQUID CRYSTAL DISPLAY (LCD), GAS PLASMA, DIGITAL LIGHT 22 PROCESSING, OR OTHER IMAGE-PROJECTION TECHNOLOGY.
- 23 (B) A UNIT MAY NOT CONTRACT FOR SERVICES TO RECYCLE COVERED 24 ELECTRONIC DEVICES UNLESS THE RECYCLER:
- 25 (1) IS A CERTIFIED E-STEWARDS RECYCLER;
- 26 (2) IS A R2 CERTIFIED RECYCLER; OR
- 27 (3) MEETS NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED AND CONSENSUS-BASED 28 ELECTRONICS RECYCLING GUIDELINES, STANDARDS, SYSTEMS APPROVED BY 29 THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not apply to any contract for services to recycle covered electronic devices that was entered into before October 1, 2012.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
