1 AN ACT concerning

2 Transportation – Highway <u>or Capital Transit</u> Construction Training and 3 Supportive Services

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration Maryland 4 Department of Transportation to use the maximum amount of certain federal $\mathbf{5}$ 6 funds available under a certain provision of federal law for highway or capital 7 transit construction training and supportive services, including skill 8 improvement programs; requiring the Department to administer certain highway construction and supportive services programs in collaboration with the 9 Governor's Workforce Investment Board for a certain purpose; requiring the 10 Administration Department and the Board to submit a certain report by a 11 12certain date each year to certain committees of the General Assembly; requiring 13 the report to include certain information; defining α certain terms; and 14generally relating to the use of federal funds for highway or capital transit 15construction training.

U.S.C. § 140(B) TO DEVELOP, CONDUCT, AND ADMINISTER HIGHWAY <u>OR</u>
<u>CAPITAL TRANSIT</u> CONSTRUCTION TRAINING AND SUPPORTIVE SERVICES,
INCLUDING SKILL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS.

8 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE TRAINING PROGRAMS 9 UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IN COLLABORATION WITH THE BOARD 10 TO ENSURE THAT HIGHWAY OR CAPITAL TRANSIT CONSTRUCTION TRAINING AND 11 SUPPORTIVE SERVICES ARE PROVIDED TO THE GREATEST EXTENT FEASIBLE TO 12 INDIVIDUALS IN EACH RELEVANT WORKFORCE INVESTMENT AREA.

13 (C) (D) (1) BY FEBRUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE ADMINISTRATION 14DEPARTMENT AND BOARD SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SENATE BUDGET AND FINANCE 15TAXATION COMMITTEE, SENATE COMMITTEE, HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE, AND HOUSE COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND 16 MEANS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT 1718 ARTICLE, A REPORT ON THE ADMINISTRATION'S DEPARTMENT'S AND BOARD'S COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION 19 20WITH RESPECT TO EACH OF THE 2 PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEARS.

PROGRAMS THE ADMINISTRATION HAS <u>DEPARTMENT AND BOARD HAVE</u>
CONDUCTED AND ADMINISTERED <u>IN EACH WORKFORCE INVESTMENT AREA,</u>
<u>INCLUDING A DESCRIPTION OF:</u>

32(II)ANALYZE THE RESULTS OF THE TRAINING PROGRAMS33IN EACH WORKFORCE INVESTMENT AREA;

34(III)STATE THE AMOUNT OF FEDERAL FUNDS AVAILABLE TO35THE STATE UNDER 23 U.S.C. § 140(B); AND

1(IV) IDENTIFYTHEAMOUNTSPENTBYTHE2ADMINISTRATION IN CONDUCTING AND ADMINISTERINGIN EACH WORKFORCE3INVESTMENT AREA TO CONDUCT AND ADMINISTERTHE PROGRAMS.
