WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE ENTRY OF A FINAL ORDER RATIFYING A SALE IN AN ACTION TO FORECLOSE A MORTGAGE OR DEED OF TRUST, THE PURCHASER AT THE FORECLOSURE SALE SHALL:

20 (1) CLOSE ON THE TRANSACTION; AND

21(2)RECORD A DEED TRANSFERRING TITLE TO THE PROPERTY TO22THE PURCHASER.
