A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Historic Motor Vehicles**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying the types of motor vehicles that are eligible for
4 registration as historic motor vehicles; increasing the age that a motor vehicle
5 must attain before it may be registered as a historic motor vehicle; prohibiting
6 certain historic motor vehicles from being used for certain purposes; requiring
7 an applicant for registration of a historic motor vehicle to submit with the
8 application a certification that the vehicle is insured by a certain vehicle
9 insurance policy; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to historic
10 motor vehicles.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Transportation**

19 13–936.

20 (a) In this section, “historic motor vehicle” means a [motor vehicle, including
21 a passenger vehicle, motorcycle, or truck] **CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE, CLASS**
22 **D (MOTORCYCLE) VEHICLE, CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE, WITH A**
23 **MANUFACTURER’S GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING OF 10,000 POUNDS OR**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **LESS, AND CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE, EXCLUDING A MOTOR HOME,**
2 that:

3 (1) Is at least ~~[20]~~ **25** years old;

4 (2) Has not been substantially altered from the manufacturer's
5 original design; and

6 (3) Meets criteria contained in regulations adopted by the
7 Administration.

8 (b) In this section, "historic motor vehicle" does not include a vehicle that has
9 been remanufactured or reconstructed as a replica of an original vehicle.

10 (c) If registered with the Administration under this section, every historic
11 motor vehicle is a Class L (historic) vehicle.

12 (d) Except as provided in subsection (i) of this section, for each Class L
13 (historic) vehicle, the annual registration fee is \$25.50.

14 (e) **(1) A HISTORIC MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS**
15 **SECTION MAY NOT BE USED:**

16 **(I) FOR GENERAL DAILY TRANSPORTATION; OR**

17 **(II) PRIMARILY FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF**
18 **PASSENGERS OR PROPERTY ON HIGHWAYS.**

19 **(2)** In applying for registration of a historic motor vehicle under this
20 section, the owner of the vehicle shall submit with the application a certification that
21 the vehicle for which the application is made:

22 ~~[(1)]~~ **(I)** Will be maintained for use in exhibitions, club activities,
23 parades, tours, ~~[occasional transportation,]~~ and similar uses; ~~[and~~

24 ~~(2)]~~ **(II)** Will not be used:

25 ~~[(i)]~~ **1.** For general daily transportation; or

26 ~~[(ii)]~~ **2.** Primarily for the transportation of passengers or
27 property on highways; **AND**

28 **(III) IS INSURED BY A HISTORIC VEHICLE, SHOW VEHICLE,**
29 **OR ANTIQUE VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICY.**

1 (f) Except as provided in § 13-936.1 of this subtitle, on registration of a
2 vehicle under this section, the Administration shall issue a special, historic motor
3 vehicle registration plate of the size and design that the Administration determines.

4 (g) Unless the presence of the equipment was specifically required by a
5 statute of this State as a condition of sale when the vehicle was manufactured, the
6 presence of any specific equipment is not required for the operation of a vehicle
7 registered under this section.

8 (h) A vehicle registered under this section is exempt from any statute that
9 requires periodic vehicle inspections or that requires the use and inspection of
10 emission controls.

11 (i) (1) For a motor vehicle manufactured at least 60 years prior to the
12 current model year, there is a onetime registration fee of \$50.00.

13 (2) Registration of a motor vehicle manufactured under this subsection
14 is not transferable to a subsequent owner.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2012.
