## Vehicle Laws - Single Registration Plate - Specified Vehicles

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue a single 4 registration plate to the owner of a vehicle that was manufactured without a means to secure and display a front registration plate; requiring the 5 6 Administration to adopt regulations establishing a means to verify, when 7 issuing a registration plate for a certain type of vehicle, that the vehicle was 8 manufactured without a means to secure and display a front registration plate; 9 requiring the Administration to adopt regulations establishing, for law 10 enforcement purposes, a means of indicating on a vehicle for which only one registration plate was issued under this Act that only one registration plate is 11 required to be displayed on the vehicle; and generally relating to vehicle 12 13 registration plates.

## **Article – Transportation** 1 2 13–410. 3 Except as otherwise provided in this title, when it registers a (a) (1) vehicle, the Administration shall issue to the owner: 4 5 (i) One registration plate, if the vehicle: 6 1. [is] **IS** a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle, Class F (tractor) 7 vehicle, or Class G (trailer) vehicle; OR 8 2. WAS MANUFACTURED WITHOUT A MEANS TO 9 SECURE AND DISPLAY A FRONT REGISTRATION PLATE; and 10 (ii) Two registration plates for every other vehicle. 11 However, as to temporary registration, the Administration may 12 provide for the issuance of only one temporary registration plate for any vehicle. 13 **(3)** THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL **ADOPT REGULATIONS** ESTABLISHING A MEANS TO VERIFY, WHEN ISSUING A REGISTRATION PLATE FOR 14 A VEHICLE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I)2 OF THIS SUBSECTION, THAT THE 15 VEHICLE WAS MANUFACTURED WITHOUT A MEANS TO SECURE AND DISPLAY A 16 17 FRONT REGISTRATION PLATE. 18 13–411. 19 On a vehicle for which one registration plate is required, the plate shall 20 be attached on the: Front of the vehicle for a Class F (tractor) vehicle; and 21(1) 22Rear of the vehicle for every other vehicle. (2) 23 It is the duty of every police officer to report to the (I)24Administration all vehicles operated in violation of this section. 25 The Administration shall verify whether the owner of a 26 reported vehicle has complied with this section. 27 **(2)**
