- [(1)] (2) [Except for a Class 6 pub-brewery license, the] **THE** holder of a distillery, rectifying, winery, limited winery, or brewery license may apply for and obtain, under a different name, one or more additional distillery, rectifying, winery, limited winery, or brewery licenses for the same or another premises.
- 7 **(3)** Those licenses may be issued to different persons or under trade 8 names used by persons occupying a part of or all of the same premises.
- 9 (4) A HOLDER OF A LICENSE LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY HOLD ADDITIONAL LICENSES LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION OF THE SAME OR OF A DIFFERENT CLASS.
- [(2)] (5) (i) The holder of a rectifying, winery, or brewery license may apply for and obtain a wholesaler's license of any class for the same premises or elsewhere as provided under this article.
- 15 (ii) The holder of a limited winery license may apply for and 16 obtain a Class 6 limited wine wholesaler's license for the same premises or elsewhere 17 as provided under this article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
