Education; and generally relating to school vehicle on-board attendants.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16Article – Transportation1716–816.

18 (a) An individual may not drive a school vehicle on any highway in this State19 unless the individual:

20 (1) Passes an appropriate medical examination; and

21 (2) For driving a school bus, has been issued a commercial driver's 22 license endorsed school bus.
