- 2 (a) In this article, unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the following 3 words have the meanings indicated.
- 4 (m) "Electronic transmission" means any form of communication, not directly involving the physical transmission of paper, that creates a record that:
- 6 (1) May be retained, retrieved, and reviewed by a recipient of the 7 communication; and
- 8 (2) May be reproduced directly in paper form by a recipient through an 9 automated process.
- 10 5–617.
- 11 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, notice of each meeting of the members shall be mailed **OR PROVIDED BY ELECTRONIC** 13 **TRANSMISSION** to each member not less than 10 days or more than 90 days before the date of the meeting.
- 15 (2) The notice shall state:
- 16 (i) The time and place of the meeting; and
- 17 (ii) If the meeting is a special meeting, the purpose of the 18 meeting.
- 19 (b) (1) A person entitled to notice of a meeting may waive notice in writing **OR BY ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION** either before or after the meeting.
- 21 (2) If a person entitled to notice of a meeting attends the meeting, the 22 person's presence shall constitute a waiver of notice of the meeting, unless the person 23 participates in the meeting solely to object to the transaction of any business because 24 the meeting has not been legally called or convened.

- 26 (a) Each member of a cooperative is entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote at a meeting of the members.
- 28 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, voting shall 29 be in person.
- 30 (2) (i) If the bylaws so provide, voting also may be by proxy, [or] by 31 mail, **OR BY ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION**[, or both].
