13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 18	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a retail service station dealer may not sell motor fuel below cost.		
19	(b) A retail service station dealer may sell motor fuel below cost if the sale is:		
20	(1) made in good faith to meet competition;		
21 22	(2) made as part of a final liquidation or closing of the business of the retail service station dealer;

3	(4)	made under the direction or order of a court or government entity.

(c) A RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER MAY NOT CHARGE MORE THAN 5 CENTS PER GALLON ABOVE COST FOR THE PRICE OF MOTOR FUEL.

- (D) If the Comptroller receives a complaint in writing that a retail service station dealer is selling motor fuel [below cost] IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, the Comptroller shall investigate and determine within 3 business days of the receipt of the complaint whether the allegations contained in the complaint are true.
- [(d)] **(E)** The Comptroller shall issue a stop sale notice and may suspend or revoke the certificate of registration of a retail service station dealer if the Comptroller determines that the retail service station dealer is in violation of this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
