## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Vehicle Laws - Historic Motor Vehicles - Trucks, Tractors, and Motor Homes

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a certain historic motor vehicle registration for 4 certain trucks, tractors, and motor homes; establishing certain qualifications for 5 a historic motor vehicle registration under this Act; establishing certain 6 registration fees; prohibiting a vehicle registered under this Act from being used 7 in a certain manner; requiring a certain owner applying for registration of a 8 vehicle under this Act to certify that the vehicle will be maintained only for 9 certain purposes; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue certain 10 registration plates under certain circumstances; providing that the presence of 11 certain equipment is not required for the operation of a vehicle registered under 12 this Act; exempting a vehicle registered under this Act from certain vehicle 13 inspections; clarifying that this Act does not limit the authority of a police officer to issue a certain safety equipment repair order; prohibiting the transfer 14 to a subsequent owner of a registration issued under this Act; defining a certain 15 16 term; and generally relating to the registration of historic motor vehicles.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
  - Article Transportation

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- 2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "HISTORIC MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS A CLASS E
- 3 (TRUCK) WITH A MANUFACTURER'S GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING IN EXCESS
- 4 OF 10,000 POUNDS, CLASS F (TRACTOR), OR A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE)
- 5 MOTOR HOME THAT:
- 6 (1) IS AT LEAST 25 YEARS OLD;
- 7 (2) HAS NOT BEEN SUBSTANTIALLY ALTERED FROM THE
- 8 MANUFACTURER'S ORIGINAL DESIGN; AND
- 9 (3) MEETS CRITERIA CONTAINED IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY
- 10 THE ADMINISTRATION.
- 11 (B) IN THIS SECTION, "HISTORIC MOTOR VEHICLE" DOES NOT INCLUDE
- 12 A VEHICLE THAT HAS BEEN REMANUFACTURED OR RECONSTRUCTED AS A
- 13 REPLICA OF AN ORIGINAL VEHICLE.
- 14 (C) IF REGISTERED WITH THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER THIS SECTION,
- 15 EVERY HISTORIC MOTOR VEHICLE IS A CLASS L (HISTORIC) VEHICLE.
- 16 (D) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (I) OF THIS SECTION, FOR
- 17 EACH CLASS L (HISTORIC) VEHICLE, THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE IS
- 18 **\$25.50**.
- 19 (E) (1) A HISTORIC MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS
- 20 SECTION MAY NOT BE USED FOR:
- 21 (I) GENERAL DAILY TRANSPORTATION; OR
- 22 (II) ANY COMMERCIAL TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS
- 23 OR PROPERTY ON HIGHWAYS.
- 24 (2) IN APPLYING FOR REGISTRATION OF A HISTORIC MOTOR
- 25 VEHICLE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE OWNER OF THE VEHICLE SHALL SUBMIT
- 26 WITH THE APPLICATION A CERTIFICATION THAT THE VEHICLE FOR WHICH THE
- 27 APPLICATION IS MADE:
- 28 (I) WILL BE MAINTAINED FOR USE IN EXHIBITIONS, CLUB
- 29 ACTIVITIES, PARADES, TOURS, AND SIMILAR USES;
  - (II) WILL NOT BE USED FOR:

1	1. GENERAL DAILY TRANSPORTATION; OR
2	2. ANY COMMERCIAL TRANSPORTATION OF
3	PASSENGERS OR PROPERTY ON HIGHWAYS; AND
4	(III) IS INSURED BY A HISTORIC VEHICLE, A SHOW VEHICLE,
5	OR AN ANTIQUE VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICY.
6	(F) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 13-936.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, ON
7	REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE UNDER THE SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION
8	SHALL ISSUE A SPECIAL, HISTORIC MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATE OF
9	THE SIZE AND DESIGN THAT THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES.
10	(G) UNLESS THE PRESENCE OF THE EQUIPMENT WAS SPECIFICALLY
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- REQUIRED BY A STATUTE OF THIS STATE AS A CONDITION OF SALE WHEN THE
  VEHICLE WAS MANUFACTURED, THE PRESENCE OF ANY SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT IS
  NOT REQUIRED FOR THE OPERATION OF A VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS
  SECTION.
- 15 (H) (1) A VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION IS EXEMPT
  16 FROM ANY STATUTE THAT REQUIRES PERIODIC VEHICLE INSPECTIONS OR THAT
  17 REQUIRES THE USE AND INSPECTION OF EMISSION CONTROLS.
- 18 (2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE
  19 CONSTRUED TO LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF A POLICE OFFICER TO ISSUE A
  20 SAFETY EQUIPMENT REPAIR ORDER FOR DEFECTIVE EQUIPMENT UNDER §
  21 23–105 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 22 (I) (1) FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE MANUFACTURED AT LEAST 60 YEARS 23 PRIOR TO THE CURRENT MODEL YEAR, THERE IS A ONETIME REGISTRATION FEE 24 OF \$50.00.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
