A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

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Institutions of Higher Education – Hiring of Outside Legal Counsel – Requirements

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a public institution of higher education and its 5 governing board to use certain resources for the provision of necessary legal 6 services under a certain amount; providing that a public institution of higher 7 education may hire certain outside legal counsel for legal services that meet or 8 exceed a certain amount only with approval of the Attorney General; requiring a 9 certain request to include certain information; prohibiting certain private nonprofit institutions of higher education that receive State aid from using the 10 State aid to hire outside legal counsel for legal services that meet or exceed a 11 12 certain amount; requiring certain private nonprofit institutions of higher 13 education to submit a certain report to the Maryland Independent College and 14 University Association on or before a certain date; requiring the Association to submit a certain report to the Maryland Higher Education Commission on or 15 16 before a certain date; providing that certain documents and reports are public 17 records; and generally relating to the requirements for the hiring of outside 18 legal counsel by institutions of higher education in the State.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 Article – Education

- 5 (A) IF THE PROJECTED COST OF LEGAL SERVICES FOR A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IS LESS THAN \$25,000 FOR A SINGLE MATTER, THE INSTITUTION AND ITS GOVERNING BOARD MAY:
- 8 (1) USE LEGAL RESOURCES THAT EXIST WITHIN THE 9 INSTITUTION TO ADDRESS THE MATTER; OR
- 10 **(2) H**IRE LEGAL COUNSEL OUTSIDE THE INSTITUTION TO 11 ADDRESS THE MATTER.
- 12 (B) (1) If the projected cost of legal services for a public 13 Institution of higher education is \$25,000 or more for a single 14 Matter, before the institution may hire legal counsel outside the 15 Institution, the institution and its governing board must request 16 And obtain approval from the Attorney General's office.
- 17 (2) THE REQUEST FOR APPROVAL TO HIRE OUTSIDE LEGAL 18 COUNSEL UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MUST BE MADE IN 19 WRITING TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE AND MUST INCLUDE:
- 20 (I) A DESCRIPTION OF THE MATTER IN WHICH THE 21 INSTITUTION SEEKS TO HIRE OUTSIDE LEGAL COUNSEL;
- 22 (II) AN EXPLANATION OF WHY THE LEGAL RESOURCES THAT 23 EXIST WITHIN THE INSTITUTION ARE NOT SUFFICIENT TO ADDRESS THE 24 MATTER;
- 25 (III) THE PROJECTED COST OF THE LEGAL SERVICES; AND
- 26 (IV) THE SOURCE OF FUNDING FOR THE LEGAL SERVICES.
- 27 (3) ANY REQUEST MADE TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE
 28 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE A PUBLIC RECORD OPEN TO INSPECTION IN
 29 ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 6 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
 30 ARTICLE.

- 4 (A) IF THE PROJECTED COST OF LEGAL SERVICES FOR A PRIVATE NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT RECEIVES STATE AID UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS \$25,000 OR MORE FOR A SINGLE MATTER, THE INSTITUTION IS PROHIBITED FROM USING THE STATE AID TO HIRE LEGAL COUNSEL OUTSIDE THE INSTITUTION TO ADDRESS THE MATTER.
- 9 (B) (1) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, EACH PRIVATE
 10 NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT RECEIVES STATE AID
 11 UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT ON THE INSTITUTION'S TOTAL
 12 EXPENDITURES FOR LEGAL SERVICES AND THE SOURCE OF FUNDING FOR
 13 LEGAL SERVICES FOR THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR TO THE MARYLAND
 14 INDEPENDENT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION.
- 15 (2) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE
 16 MARYLAND INDEPENDENT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION SHALL
 17 SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE COMMISSION THAT COMPILES THE INFORMATION
 18 RECEIVED FROM EACH PRIVATE NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
 19 EDUCATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 20 (3) A REPORT SUBMITTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE A
 21 PUBLIC RECORD OPEN TO INSPECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10,
 22 SUBTITLE 6 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
