2 Montgomery County – Solicitation and Collection of Money or Donations 3 from Occupants of Vehicles – Adoption of a Permit Program

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Montgomery County Council to enact a local law 6 to require a person to obtain a certain permit before standing in a roadway or 7 median divider or on a sidewalk adjacent to a roadway to solicit and collect 8 money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle; prohibiting a 9 person from standing, or causing, encouraging, allowing, or petitioning a person 10 to stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection, or on a sidewalk adjacent 11 to a roadway, to solicit or collect money or donations from the occupant of a 12 vehicle, if a certain permit is required under a local law enacted under this Act and the permit has not been obtained in accordance with the local law; 13 prohibiting a local law enacted under this Act from authorizing a permit to be 14 15 issued to a minor for certain purposes; and generally relating to the solicitation 16 and collection of money or donations from occupants of vehicles in Montgomery 17 County.

1	(g)	(1)	THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN MONTGOMERY	COUNTY.

- [(1)] (2) (I) [In Montgomery County, a] A child under the age of 18 years may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit OR COLLECT money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.
- [(2)] (II) This [subsection] PARAGRAPH shall be enforced by the issuance of a warning that informs the offender of the requirements of this [subsection] PARAGRAPH.
- 8 (3) (I) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL MAY ENACT A
 9 LOCAL LAW TO REQUIRE A PERSON TO OBTAIN A PERMIT BEFORE THE PERSON
 10 MAY STAND IN A ROADWAY OR MEDIAN DIVIDER OR ON A SIDEWALK ADJACENT

- 20 **2.** CAUSE, ENCOURAGE, ALLOW, OR PETITION A
 21 PERSON TO STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION, OR ON
 22 A SIDEWALK ADJACENT TO A ROADWAY, TO SOLICIT OR COLLECT MONEY OR
 23 DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.
- 24 (III) A LOCAL LAW ENACTED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT
 25 AUTHORIZE A PERMIT TO BE ISSUED TO A MINOR FOR THE PURPOSE OF
 26 STANDING IN A ROADWAY OR MEDIAN DIVIDER TO SOLICIT OR COLLECT MONEY
 27 OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.
