- 1 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "RURAL ZONE" MEANS AN AREA OF
  2 MONTGOMERY COUNTY DESIGNATED AS A RURAL ZONE, RURAL CLUSTER
  3 ZONE, RURAL DENSITY TRANSFER ZONE, RURAL NEIGHBORHOOD CLUSTER
  4 ZONE, OR RURAL SERVICE ZONE AS DESCRIBED IN THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY
  5 CODE ZONING ORDINANCE.
- 6 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, (B) **(1)** IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, AN ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM OR WELL 7 8 LOCATED IN A RURAL ZONE MAY ONLY SERVE ONE ADDITIONAL LOT OR PARCEL 9 THAT HAS BEEN SUBDIVIDED FROM A SINGLE PROPERTY ON WHICH THE 10 ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM OR WELL IS LOCATED UNDER AN ON-SITE 11 SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM EASEMENT OR WELL EASEMENT, RESPECTIVELY, 12 PROVIDED THAT:
- 13 (I) THE PROPERTY ON WHICH THE ON-SITE SEWAGE 14 DISPOSAL SYSTEM OR WELL IS LOCATED DOES NOT HAVE AN EXISTING ON-SITE 15 SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM EASEMENT OR WELL EASEMENT;
- 16 (II) THE SUBDIVISION OF THE PROPERTY WAS MADE IN
  17 ACCORDANCE WITH A STATE OR COUNTY AGRICULTURAL LAND CONSERVATION
  18 PROGRAM IF THE PROPERTY IS SUBJECT TO AN AGRICULTURAL LAND
  19 CONSERVATION EASEMENT; AND
- 20 (III) ONLY ONE ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM 21 EASEMENT MAY SERVE ONLY ONE SUBDIVIDED LOT OR PARCEL.
- 22 (2) AN EASEMENT FOR AN ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM
  23 OR WELL UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE A LOT-TO-LOT
  24 OR PARCEL TO PARCEL EASEMENT SO LONG AS BOTH LOTS OR PARCELS
  25 ORIGINATE FROM THE SAME PROPERTY GRANTED FROM THE ORIGINAL PARCEL
  26 TO A NEW LOT OR PARCEL BEING CREATED AND THE EASEMENT MUST NOT BE
  27 GRANTED TO ANY LOT OR PARCEL THAT DID NOT ORIGINATE FROM THE SAME
  28 ORIGINAL PARCEL.
- 29 (C) AN ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM OR WELL UNDER 30 SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT:
- 31 (1) SERVE LAND THAT IS DESIGNATED BY THE STATE OR THE 32 GOVERNING BODY OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY AS A SPECIAL PROTECTION AREA 33 OR GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE; OR
- 34 (2) DECREASE THE LAND AVAILABLE FOR AGRICULTURAL 35 PRODUCTION BY MORE THAN 4,000 SQUARE FEET.
