11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
13	Article – Family Law
14	9–102.
15	(A) An equity court may:
16 17	(1) consider a petition for reasonable visitation of a grandchild by a grandparent; and
18 19 20	(2) [if the court finds it to be in the best interests of the child,] grant visitation rights to the grandparent IF THE COURT FINDS BY A PREPONDERANCE OF THE EVIDENCE THAT:
21 22	(I) VISITATION WITH THE GRANDPARENT IS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CHILD; AND

1	(II) 1. THE CHILD'S HEALTH OR WELFARE WILL BE
2	HARMED IF VISITATION TO THE GRANDPARENT IS DENIED; OR
3	2. OTHER EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST.
4	(B) IN DETERMINING WHETHER THE CHILD'S HEALTH OR WELFARE
5	WILL BE HARMED IF VISITATION TO THE GRANDPARENT IS DENIED, OR
6	WHETHER OTHER EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST, THE COURT SHALL
7	CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING FACTORS:
8	(1) THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE CHILD AND THE

10	(2) THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN EACH OF THE CHILD'S PARENTS

12	(3) THE TIME THAT HAS ELAPSED SINCE THE CHILD LAST HAD

- 19 **(6)** WHETHER THE GRANDPARENT IS SEEKING VISITATION IN 20 GOOD FAITH; AND
- 21 (7) ANY OTHER FACTOR THE COURT CONSIDERS RELEVANT IN 22 MAKING A DETERMINATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
