3 FOR the purpose of establishing the State Personnel Disability Accommodation Fund 4 as a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the $\mathbf{5}$ Secretary of Budget and Management to administer the Fund; requiring the 6 State Treasurer to hold the Fund and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; 7 specifying the contents of the Fund; specifying the purpose for which the Fund 8 may be used; providing for the investment of money in and expenditures from 9 the Fund; providing for the reimbursement of certain money to the Fund; requiring a certain appropriation to the Fund for a certain fiscal year; defining a 10 certain term; and generally relating to the State Personnel Disability 11 12Accommodation Fund.

6 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE 7 FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

8 (2) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE 9 CREDITED TO THE FUND.

10 (I) THE SECRETARY SHALL:

11 (1) ADOPT REGULATIONS SPECIFYING HOW EXPENDITURES MAY 12 BE MADE FROM THE FUND, INCLUDING APPLICATION AND DISBURSEMENT 13 PROCEDURES; AND

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(2) **PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO USERS OF THE FUND.**

(J) PRINCIPAL UNITS THAT RECEIVE DISBURSEMENTS FROM THE FUND
 SHALL REIMBURSE THE AMOUNT RECEIVED TO THE FUND NO LATER THAN THE
 END OF THE FIRST MONTH OF THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR.

(a) (2) (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and unless
inconsistent with a federal law, grant agreement, or other federal requirement or with
the terms of a gift or settlement agreement, net interest on all State money allocated
by the State Treasurer under this section to special funds or accounts, and otherwise
entitled to receive interest earnings, as accounted for by the Comptroller, shall accrue
to the General Fund of the State.
