CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from standing in a highway in Baltimore 5 County to solicit money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle, except 6 under certain circumstances; prohibiting an adult from encouraging or allowing 7 a child to stand in a highway in Baltimore County to solicit money or donations 8 from the occupant of a vehicle; providing that a child may not be found guilty or 9 adjudicated delinquent for standing in a highway in Baltimore County to solicit money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle if an adult encouraged or 10 allowed the child to commit the violation; providing for the issuance of that a 11 person standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection in Baltimore 12 County who solicits money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle without a 13 certain permit is subject to a certain warning to as a first-time offender; 14 providing and to a certain penalty for subsequent offenses; defining a certain 15 16 term: and generally relating to restrictions on the use of highways in Baltimore 17 County for penalties for solicitation of money or donations without a permit while standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection in Baltimore 18 19 County.
