- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain volunteer fire departments in Prince George's 5 County to hold poker events in which the public may play poker card games; 6 limiting the number of poker events that a volunteer fire department may hold; 7 requiring that a volunteer fire department obtain a permit from the Prince 8 George's County Department of Environmental Resources before holding a 9 poker event; limiting the days on which poker events may be held; specifying a 10 certain requirement that a volunteer fire department must meet to qualify for a 11 permit; specifying that the Department may issue permits under certain circumstances; specifying the period for which a permit is valid; allowing a 12 permit to be renewed under certain circumstances; specifying that the 13 conditions under which a permit for a poker event is issued shall be the same 14 15 with certain exceptions that apply to a charitable gaming event permit under 16 the Prince George's County Code; and generally relating to volunteer fire 17 departments and poker events in Prince George's County.

- 14 (I) IS VALID FOR 6 MONTHS AFTER IT IS ISSUED; AND
- 15 (II) MAY BE RENEWED UNLESS THE PERMIT HOLDER FAILS 16 TO COMPLY WITH COUNTY LAW.
- 17 (8) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPHS (1) AND (2) OF
 18 THIS SUBSECTION, CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH A PERMIT FOR A POKER EVENT
 19 IS ISSUED SHALL BE THE SAME AS THOSE THAT APPLY TO A CHARITABLE
 20 GAMING EVENT PERMIT UNDER SUBTITLE 5, DIVISION 2 OF THE PRINCE
 21 GEORGE'S COUNTY CODE, INCLUDING REQUIREMENTS FOR PERMIT
 22 APPLICATIONS, USE OF PROCEEDS, HOURS OF OPERATION, WORKER LICENSING,
 23 ORGANIZATIONAL REPORTING, FEES, AND PRIZE AMOUNTS.
- [(c)] (D) A person who violates this section or a county ordinance enacted under this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or both.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
