- (B) IF A REPORT ISSUED BY THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS
  UNDER § 2–1224 OF THIS TITLE CONTAINS THREE OR MORE REPEAT FINDINGS,
  THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL REDUCE THE AMOUNT INCLUDED IN THE
  BUDGET BILL SUBMITTED BY THE GOVERNOR IN JANUARY EACH YEAR FOR THE
  UNIT THAT WAS THE SUBJECT OF THE REPORT BY UP TO 5% EACH FISCAL YEAR
  UNTIL THE UNIT REPORTS TO THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS AND THE
  OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS DETERMINES THAT THE UNIT HAS
  SATISFACTORILY ADDRESSED THE REPEAT FINDINGS.
