3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the deferral of payment of a certain portion of a fee for 4 the registration of vehicles in certain vehicle classifications subject to certain $\mathbf{5}$ requirements; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to register or renew 6 the registration of a vehicle of an applicant who pays the registration fee in 7 accordance with this Act; authorizing the Administration to revoke the 8 registration of the vehicle of a certain person who fails to pay the vehicle 9 registration fee in accordance with certain requirements; requiring the Administration to adopt regulations to implement this Act; providing for the 10 termination of this Act; and generally relating to vehicle registration and 11 12payment of fees for vehicle registration.
