16	(a) This section does not apply to an individual sentenced in Baltimore City.
17 18	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, a judge may not sentence an individual to the jurisdiction of the Division for 12 months or less unless [:
19 20	(1) the sentence is for an offense committed by an inmate in a correctional facility under the jurisdiction of the Division; and
21 22	(2)] the INDIVIDUAL IS AN inmate [is still] under the jurisdiction of the Division.
