## A BILL ENTITLED

## AN ACT concerning

State Lottery Agency - Education Lottery
FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Agency to conduct a certain monthly lottery for the benefit of the public school systems in the State; requiring the Comptroller to pay to the public school systems in the State a certain percentage of the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of a certain lottery after a certain distribution; requiring the Agency to meet certain advertising criteria in conducting the lottery; specifying that the proceeds distributed under this Act to a public school system are intended to provide additional revenue distributed to public school systems; defining a certain term; and generally relating to lotteries conducted by the State Lottery Agency.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

(a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:
(1) on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, the expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under this subtitle and the State budget; and
(2) then, except as provided in § 10-113.1 of the Family Law Article and § 11-618 of the Criminal Procedure Article, the holder of each winning ticket or share.
(b) (1) Promptly after the 1st day of each month, the Comptroller shall pay:
(i) into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted for the benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority, after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section; [and]
(II) TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN THE STATE 20\% OF THE MONEY THAT REMAINS IN THE STATE LOTTERY FUND FROM THE PROCEEDS OF AN EDUCATION LOTTERY CONDUCTED EACH MONTH UNDER § 9-120.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE, AFTER THE DISTRIBUTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND
[(ii)] (III) into the General Fund of the State the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all other lotteries after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section.
(2) The money paid into the General Fund under this subsection is available in the fiscal year in which the money accumulates in the State Lottery Fund.
(c) The regulations of the Agency shall apportion the money in the State Lottery Fund.

## 9-120.2.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM" MEANS THE COLLECTION OF PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOOLS UNDER THE CONTROL OF A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF School Commissioners of Baltimore City.
(B) ON THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MONTH, BEGINNING ON NOVEMBER 1, 2012, THE AGENCY SHALL CONDUCT AN EDUCATION LOTTERY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN THE STATE.
(C) In ALL ADVERTISING AND ON ALL TICKETS, THE AGENCY SHALL IDENTIFY ANY LOTTERY CONDUCTED UNDER THIS SECTION AS BEING CONDUCTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN THE STATE.
(D) (1) THE AMOUNT DISTRIBUTED TO EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM UNDER THE DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENT UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE PROPORTIONATE TO THE AMOUNT OF SALES OF LOTTERY TICKETS MADE IN THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN WHICH THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IS LOCATED.
(2) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL USE THE MONEY FROM THE SALE OF STATE LOTTERY TICKETS THAT IS DISTRIBUTED UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR:
(I) CLASSROOM STAFF; AND
(II) INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS.
(E) THE PROCEEDS PAID INTO THE GENERAL FUND UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE USED TO HELP PROVIDE AN ADEQUATE EDUCATION FOR THE STUDENTS ATTENDING PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE STATE IN PREKINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 12 THROUGH THE BRIDGE to Excellence in Public Schools Program, enacted by Chapter 288 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002.
(F) A DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
