- 9 (1) THE CUSTOMER IS AT LEAST 65 YEARS OF AGE AND HAS 10 NOTIFIED THE ELECTRIC COMPANY OF THAT FACT; AND
- 11 (2) THE CUSTOMER'S SERVICE HAS NOT BEEN INTERRUPTED IN 12 THE PREVIOUS 12 MONTHS DUE TO A FAILURE TO PAY AN ELECTRIC BILL.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
