BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 10–410(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (2007 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Natural Resources 10-410. (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), (4), and (6) of this (a) subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays.
