## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Property Tax – Credit for Individuals At Least 60 Years Old

# FOR the purpose of altering the minimum age for purposes of a certain property tax credit that the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a county or of a municipal corporation are authorized to grant; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to enabling authority for a certain property tax credit for certain real property owned by and used as the principal residence of certain individuals of a certain age and of limited income.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- Article Tax Property
- 17 9–245.

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18 (a) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a 19 county or of a municipal corporation may grant, by law, a tax credit against the county 20 or municipal corporation property tax imposed on real property that is owned by and 21 used as the principal residence of an individual who is at least [65] **60** years old and of 22 limited income.

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 June 1, 2012, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 3 2012.
