- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain buildings owned by the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to be high performance buildings under certain 5 6 circumstances; exempting certain building types from certain high performance 7 building standards; authorizing the Commission to request a certain waiver 8 from certain high performance building standards from a certain county; 9 authorizing a certain county council, with approval of the county executive, to 10 issue a certain waiver under certain circumstances; expressing a certain intent of the General Assembly; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the 11 Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission and high performance buildings. 12

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE
- 23 MEANINGS INDICATED.

- 1 (2) "HIGH PERFORMANCE BUILDING" MEANS A BUILDING THAT:
- 2 (I) MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE CURRENT VERSION OF THE
- 3 U.S. GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL'S LEADERSHIP IN ENERGY AND
- 4 ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN (LEED) GREEN BUILDING RATING SYSTEM SILVER
- 5 RATING; OR
- 6 (II) ACHIEVES AT LEAST A COMPARABLE NUMERIC RATING
- 7 ACCORDING TO A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED, ACCEPTED, AND APPROPRIATE
- 8 NUMERIC SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT RATING SYSTEM, GUIDELINE, OR
- 9 STANDARD APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT AND
- 10 THE SECRETARY OF GENERAL SERVICES.
- 11 (3) "MAJOR RENOVATION" MEANS THE RENOVATION OF A
- 12 BUILDING WHERE:
- 13 (I) THE BUILDING SHELL IS TO BE REUSED FOR THE NEW
- 14 CONSTRUCTION;
- 15 (II) THE HEATING, VENTILATING, AND AIR-CONDITIONING
- 16 (HVAC), ELECTRICAL, AND PLUMBING SYSTEMS ARE TO BE REPLACED; AND
- 17 (III) THE SCOPE OF THE RENOVATION IS 7,500 SQUARE FEET
- 18 OR GREATER.
- 19 (B) It is the intent of the General Assembly that, to the
- 20 EXTENT PRACTICABLE:
- 21 (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL EMPLOY GREEN BUILDING
- 22 TECHNOLOGIES WHEN CONSTRUCTING OR RENOVATING A COMMISSION-OWNED
- 23 BUILDING NOT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION; AND
- 24 (2) HIGH PERFORMANCE BUILDINGS SHALL MEET THE CRITERIA
- 25 AND STANDARDS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE "HIGH EFFICIENCY GREEN
- 26 BUILDING PROGRAM" ADOPTED BY THE MARYLAND GREEN BUILDING
- 27 COUNCIL.
- 28 (C) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (D) AND (E) OF THIS
- 29 SECTION, IF A CAPITAL PROJECT INCLUDES THE CONSTRUCTION OR MAJOR
- 30 RENOVATION OF A BUILDING THAT IS 7,500 SQUARE FEET OR GREATER, THE
- 31 BUILDING SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED OR RENOVATED TO BE A HIGH
- 32 PERFORMANCE BUILDING.

11	(E) (1) THE COMMISSION MAY REQUEST FROM THE COUNTY WHERE				
12	THE PROPOSED CAPITAL PROJECT IS LOCATED A WAIVER FROM COMPLYING				
13	WITH SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.				
14	(2) ON RECEIPT OF A WRITTEN REQUEST OF A WAIVER UNDER				
15	THIS SUBSECTION, WITH APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, THE COUNTY				
16	COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY WHERE THE PROPOSED CAPITAL PROJECT IS				
17	LOCATED MAY ISSUE A WAIVER UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IF THE COUNTY				
18	COUNCIL DETERMINES THAT THE USE OF A HIGH PERFORMANCE BUILDING IN A				
19	PROPOSED CAPITAL PROJECT IS NOT PRACTICABLE.
