Health Occupations - Public Disclosure of Professional Credentials

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain advertisements for health care services to 4 identify and fully spell out the license or certification of certain health care 5 practitioners; prohibiting a certain advertisement from being misleading; 6 specifying what constitutes a misleading advertisement under this Act; 7 requiring certain health care practitioners to disclose the practitioner's 8 licensure or certification by wearing a certain identification tag; providing for 9 the application of a certain provision of this Act; providing that health care 10 practitioners that fail to comply with certain provisions of this Act are subject to 11 certain disciplinary actions; authorizing the appropriate regulatory board to 12 investigate an alleged violation of certain provisions of this Act; requiring certain regulatory boards to adopt certain regulations; prohibiting a physician 13 from making certain representations to the public under certain circumstances; 14 15 altering the authority of a physician to advertise; defining certain terms; and 16 generally relating to the public disclosure of professional credentials by health 17 care practitioners.

- 1 (A) AN ADVERTISEMENT FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES THAT NAMES A 2 HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER:
- 3 (1) SHALL IDENTIFY AND FULLY SPELL OUT THE LICENSE OR 4 CERTIFICATION HELD BY THE HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER; AND
- 5 (2) MAY NOT BE MISLEADING.
- 6 (B) AN ADVERTISEMENT IS MISLEADING FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IF THE HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY INCLUDES IN THE ADVERTISEMENT A COMMUNICATION OR REPRESENTATION THAT:
- 10 (1) MISSTATES OR FALSELY DESCRIBES THE HEALTH CARE
 11 PRACTITIONER'S PROFESSION, SKILLS, TRAINING, EXPERTISE, EDUCATION,
 12 LICENSURE, OR CERTIFICATION; OR
- 13 **(2)** HOLDS THE HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER OUT AS HAVING SKILLS, TRAINING, EXPERTISE, EDUCATION, LICENSURE, OR CERTIFICATION THAT THE HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER DOES NOT HAVE.

- 17 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER
 18 WHO WORKS IN A NONPATIENT CARE SETTING OR WHO DOES NOT DIRECTLY

- 20 (B) A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER WHO PROVIDES HEALTH CARE

- 14 BOARD, INCLUDING A MULTIDISCIPLINARY BOARD, OR THAT THE PHYSICIAN IS
- 15 BOARD CERTIFIED UNLESS:
- 16 (1) THE ADVERTISEMENT INCLUDES THE FULL NAME OF THE
- 17 BOARD FROM WHICH THE PHYSICIAN IS CERTIFIED AND THE NAME OF THE
- 18 SPECIALTY OR SUBSPECIALTY IN WHICH THE PHYSICIAN IS CERTIFIED; AND
- 19 (2) THE CERTIFYING BOARD MEETS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING
