3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Human Resources to establish the 4 Couples Advancing Together Pilot Program in the Department of Human $\mathbf{5}$ Resources; requiring the Program to be established in at least a certain number 6 of counties in the State; requiring the Secretary to cooperate with certain local 7 directors of social services and to consult with the Commission on Responsible 8 Fatherhood regarding the establishment of the Program; establishing the intent 9 of the Program; providing for the components of the Program including the implementation of certain policies and procedures in certain local departments. 10 the development of a certain referral process or certain integrated partnerships 11 12for certain couples, and the implementation of certain program requirements; 13 establishing certain age requirements for eligibility to participate in the Program; requiring the Secretary to submit a certain annual report to the 14Senate Finance Committee and the House Appropriations Committee; providing 1516 for the contents of the annual report; defining a certain term; providing for the 17termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Couples Advancing 18 Together Pilot Program and the Family Investment Program.

²⁴ SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 **5–318.1.**

2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE COUPLES ADVANCING 3 TOGETHER PILOT PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.

4 (B) (1) IN COOPERATION WITH THE LOCAL DIRECTORS, AND IN 5 CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSION ON RESPONSIBLE FATHERHOOD, THE 6 SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH A COUPLES ADVANCING TOGETHER PILOT 7 PROGRAM.

8 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO ASSIST COUPLES THAT 9 QUALIFY AS A FAMILY ELIGIBLE FOR THE FIP TO MOVE TOWARD STABLE 10 RELATIONSHIPS AND FAMILY-FRIENDLY EMPLOYMENT, FOR ONE OR BOTH 11 PARTNERS, IN ORDER TO IMPROVE THEIR ECONOMIC CIRCUMSTANCES AND 12 PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR LASTING FAMILY UNITS.

- 30 (D) (1) THE PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE A 6-WEEK PARTICIPATION 31 PERIOD DURING WHICH COUPLES RECEIVE EDUCATION ON, AND ARE PROVIDED 32 WITH THE TOOLS NEEDED FOR, ACHIEVING SUCCESS AT HOME, IN THE 33 WORKPLACE, AND IN SOCIETY.

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$\frac{1}{2}$	(2) WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF SUBJECT MATTER EXPERTS IDENTIFIED BY THE SECRETARY AND LOCAL DIRECTORS, COUPLES SHALL:

4 5	(II) LEARN SKILLS THAT ARE REQUIRED TO COMPETE IN THE JOB MARKET; AND
