- 18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "UTILITY SERVICE" MEANS WATER, ELECTRICITY,
 19 GAS, OR OIL SERVICE.
- 20 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A COUNCIL OF UNIT OWNERS THAT 21 IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING BILLS FOR UTILITY SERVICE ON BEHALF OF ALL
- 22 THE UNITS OF A CONDOMINIUM.

1 (C) IF A UNIT OWNER IS 90 DAYS OR MORE DELINQUENT IN PAYMENTS 2 TO THE COUNCIL OF UNIT OWNERS FROM WHICH BILLS FOR UTILITY SERVICE 3 ARE PAID BY THE COUNCIL OF UNIT OWNERS, THE COUNCIL OF UNIT OWNERS 4 MAY PETITION THE DISTRICT COURT TO TURN OFF UTILITY SERVICE TO THE 5 UNIT.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2012.
