A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Environment - Reduction of Lead Risk in Housing - Renovations and Repairs

FOR the purpose of requiring an activity that disturbs more than a certain number of feet of painted surface in certain residential dwellings to pass a certain test for lead-contaminated dust; authorizing the Department of the Environment to administer a certain program consistent with certain federal regulations; requiring the Department to seek authorization to enforce certain federal regulations on or before a certain date; and generally relating to renovations and repairs that disturb lead-based paint.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 EXCEPT FOR AFFECTED PROPERTIES THAT ARE SUBJECT TO MORE 21 STRINGENT REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, AN ACTIVITY THAT 22 DISTURBS MORE THAN 3 SQUARE FEET OF PAINTED SURFACE IN AN 23 OWNER-OCCUPIED RESIDENTIAL DWELLING UNIT BUILT BEFORE 1978 OR A 24 RESIDENTIAL RENTAL UNIT BUILT BEFORE 1978 SHALL PASS THE TEST FOR 25 LEAD-CONTAMINATED DUST UNDER § 6-816 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

2 THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADMINISTER A RENOVATION, REPAIR, AND 3 PAINTING PROGRAM CONSISTENT WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION 4 AGENCY'S RENOVATION, REPAIR AND PAINTING RULE, 40 C.F.R. 745, 5 SUBPART E.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of the 7 Environment shall seek authorization to enforce the Environmental Protection 8 Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule on or before March 31, 2013.

10 October 1, 2012.

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
