## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## Maryland Small Business Resources Workgroup

FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Small Business Resources Workgroup; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Workgroup; prohibiting a member of the Workgroup from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Workgroup to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Workgroup to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Maryland Small Business Resources Workgroup.

12 Preamble

WHEREAS, The Linked Deposit Program in the Department of Housing and Community Development is a statewide initiative designed to stimulate growth opportunities for certified minority business enterprises by reducing the interest rate on loans the businesses obtain from participating banks and by providing access to affordable capital to grow and expand minority business enterprises; and

WHEREAS, Certified minority business enterprises that qualify for the Linked Deposit Program in the Department of Housing and Community Development can receive a 2% discount on their loans from participating financial institutions; and

WHEREAS, To qualify for the Linked Deposit Program in the Department of Housing and Community Development, a borrower must notify the Department prior to obtaining a qualifying loan from a financial institution enrolled in the Linked Deposit Program, be certified by the Maryland Department of Transportation as a minority business enterprise, and be using the loan for a project or activity located in Maryland; and



- WHEREAS, Loans enrolled in the Linked Deposit Program are not a debt of the State, nor is the State liable to any financial institution for payment of the principal or interest on a loan assisted by a linked deposit; and
- WHEREAS, According to the U.S. Small Business Administration report, Maryland small businesses represent 98% of employers in the State; and
- WHEREAS, The Linked Deposit Program provides the opportunity for Maryland small businesses to leverage \$50 million in State—backed funds to reduce the cost of capital for certified minority business enterprises; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In 2010, only \$4 million in Linked Deposit Program resources was 10 utilized by Maryland minority business enterprises because of a reluctance among 11 lenders to issue loans to qualified minority business enterprises; now, therefore,
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (a) There is a Maryland Small Business Resources Workgroup.
- 15 (b) The Workgroup consists of the following members:
- 16 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 17 President of the Senate;

- 20 (3) the Secretary of Business and Economic Development, or the 21 Secretary's designee;
- 22 (4) the Secretary of Housing and Community Development, or the 23 Secretary's designee;
- 24 (5) the Secretary of Transportation, or the Secretary's designee;
- 25 (6) the State Treasurer, or the Treasurer's designee;
- 26 (7) the Executive Director of the Governor's Office of Minority Affairs, or the Executive Director's designee;
- 28 (8) one member of the Maryland Bankers Association Board of 29 Directors, appointed by the Board of Directors;
- 30 (9) the Executive Director of the Maryland Small Business 31 Development and Financing Authority, or the Executive Director's designee;
