Environment – Gas and Oil Leasing Agent – Notice to Landowner

- FOR the purpose of requiring a certain leasing agent to provide certain written notice to a landowner before presenting the landowner with a certain gas and oil lease; authorizing the Department of the Environment to adopt certain regulations; establishing certain grounds for the denial of a certain gas and oil permit; defining a certain term; and generally relating to notice of the rights of a landowner associated with gas and oil leases.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 **14–113.1.**
- 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "LEASING AGENT" MEANS A PERSON THAT
- 19 CONTACTS A LANDOWNER FOR THE PURPOSE OF LEASING MINERAL RIGHTS FOR
- 20 THE EXPLORATION, PRODUCTION, OR UNDERGROUND STORAGE OF GAS OR OIL
- 21 IN THE STATE.
- 22 (2) "LEASING AGENT" INCLUDES A LANDMAN.

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1	(B) BEFORE PRESENTING A LANDOWNER WITH A LEASE FOR THE RIGHT
2	TO DRILL A WELL FOR THE EXPLORATION, PRODUCTION, OR UNDERGROUND
3	STORAGE OF GAS OR OIL IN THE STATE, A LEASING AGENT SHALL PROVIDE THE
4	LANDOWNER WRITTEN NOTICE DESCRIBING THE RIGHTS OF THE LANDOWNER,
5	INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO:

- (1) CONTACT AN ATTORNEY; AND
- 7 (2) NEGOTIATE THE TERMS OF THE LEASE.
- 8 (C) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT BY REGULATION ADDITIONAL 9 REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.
- 10 (D) FAILURE TO PROVIDE THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION MAY
 11 BE GROUNDS FOR THE DENIAL OF A PERMIT FOR THE DRILLING OF A WELL FOR
 12 THE EXPLORATION, PRODUCTION, OR UNDERGROUND STORAGE OF GAS OR OIL
 13 IN THE STATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
