2 Elementary and Secondary Education – County–Supervised Home 3 Instruction – High School Diploma

- FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain individual who received home instruction under the supervision of a county board of education to apply to a certain county board to obtain a high school diploma under certain circumstances; requiring a certain county board to award a high school diploma to certain individuals; requiring a certain county board to adopt certain rules and regulations; and generally relating to obtaining a high school diploma for the completion of county—supervised home instruction for elementary and secondary education.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVED HOME INSTRUCTION UNDER THE
 21 SUPERVISION OF A COUNTY BOARD MAY APPLY TO OBTAIN A HIGH SCHOOL
 22 DIPLOMA IF THE INDIVIDUAL COMPLETED THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A HOME
 23 INSTRUCTION PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS OF THE

- 1 (B) TO OBTAIN A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF 2 THIS SECTION, THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL APPLY TO THE COUNTY BOARD IN THE 3 COUNTY THAT SUPERVISED THE INDIVIDUAL'S HOME INSTRUCTION.
- 4 (C) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL AWARD A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA TO 5 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 6 (D) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO 7 ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR AWARDING DIPLOMAS UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 July 1, 2012.
