## State Department of Education – Virtual Learning Opportunities – Survey and Report

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to conduct a survey of the county boards of education to make a certain determination about the use of virtual learning opportunities for students; requiring the Department to submit a certain report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; requiring the Department to develop and adopt certain guidelines and policies regarding the utilization of certain virtual learning opportunities; and generally relating to a survey and report of virtual learning opportunities by the State Department of Education.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:

- 14 (a) The State Department of Education shall conduct a survey of the county 15 boards of education to determine each local school system's current use of virtual 16 learning opportunities for students in the county.
- 17 (b) On or before December 1, 2012, the State Department of Education shall 18 report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government 19 Article, on the current utilization of virtual learning opportunities for students across 20 the State.
- 21 (c) Using the results of the survey required under subsection (a) of this section, the State Department of Education shall develop and adopt guidelines and policies that enhance the utilization of virtual learning opportunities for all students in the State.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 1 2
- July 1, 2012.
