A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Gas Companies - Service Extension - Costs

FOR the purpose of authorizing the owners of certain residential properties in a certain area who request extension of gas service to the area by a gas company to obtain a certain alternative proposal; requiring a certain alternative proposal to contain certain information, meet certain standards, and provide for payment in a certain manner; requiring the Public Service Commission to establish a certain methodology for comparing certain proposals; authorizing certain property owners to select between certain proposals for a gas service extension; establishing certain standards for the installation of certain gas service extensions; requiring the approval of a certain utility construction company by the Commission or the gas company under certain circumstances; providing that a certain gas service extension becomes the property of the gas company on completion and execution of a certain agreement; providing for the payment for the gas service extension; prohibiting a gas company from discriminating between certain gas customers on a certain basis; requiring each gas company to publish certain information in a certain manner; providing for the adoption by the Commission of certain procedures in a certain manner; providing for the purpose and application of this Act; and generally relating to gas service extensions.

- 2 (A) THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION IS TO PROMOTE ACCESS BY THE
 3 PUBLIC TO PUBLIC UTILITY SERVICES AND TO ENCOURAGE THE CONVERSION
 4 OF RESIDENTIAL COMBUSTION-BASED HEATING SYSTEMS TO NATURAL GAS
 5 FROM HEATING OIL, WOOD, AND OTHER MATERIALS IN ORDER TO DECREASE
 6 THE LEVEL OF PARTICULATES AND OTHER POLLUTANTS RESULTING FROM
 7 HOME HEATING COMBUSTION.
- 8 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO THE EXTENSION OF GAS MAINS, SERVICE 9 LINES, AND OTHER GAS PLANT TO RESIDENTIAL AREAS NOT CURRENTLY 10 RECEIVING GAS SUPPLY FROM A GAS COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF 11 CONVERTING EXISTING COMBUSTION HEATING SYSTEMS TO NATURAL GAS.
- 12 IN THE CASE OF A REQUEST FOR A GAS COMPANY TO EXTEND 13 GAS SERVICE TO THREE OR MORE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES IN A DEFINED AREA, THE PROPERTY OWNERS SHALL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO SEEK AN 14 ALTERNATIVE ESTIMATED INSTALLATION COST PROPOSAL FROM A UTILITY 15 16 CONSTRUCTION COMPANY CHOSEN BY THE PROPERTY OWNERS TO COMPARE 17 WITH THE GAS COMPANY'S ESTIMATED INSTALLATION COST OF THE NECESSARY 18 GAS MAINS, SERVICE LINES, AND OTHER GAS PLANT AND INSTALLATION 19 SERVICES NECESSARY TO PROVIDE GAS SUPPLY TO THE RESIDENTIAL 20 PROPERTIES.
- 21 (2) AN ALTERNATIVE ESTIMATED INSTALLATION COST PROPOSAL 22 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL:
- 23 (I) INCLUDE THE SAME REQUIRED GAS MAINS, SERVICE 24 LINES, AND OTHER GAS PLANT AND INSTALLATION SERVICES AS ARE INCLUDED 25 IN THE ESTIMATE FROM THE GAS COMPANY;
- 26 (II) MEET OR EXCEED ALL APPLICABLE SAFETY AND 27 PERFORMANCE STANDARDS, INCLUDING ENGINEERING, QUALITY, AND 28 INTERCONNECTION STANDARDS, THAT ARE REQUIRED FOR GAS PLANT THAT 29 THE GAS COMPANY INSTALLS FOR ITS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM; AND
- 30 (III) PROVIDE FOR ANTICIPATED PAYMENT FOR THE GAS
 31 SERVICE EXTENSION THROUGH A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE PROPERTY
 32 OWNERS AS GAS CUSTOMERS IN THE SAME MANNER THAT A CONTRIBUTION
 33 WOULD BE REQUIRED FOR AN EXTENSION INSTALLED BY THE GAS COMPANY.

- 1 (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH A METHODOLOGY FOR 2 THE GAS COMPANY AND THE PROPERTY OWNERS TO COMPARE THE 3 INSTALLATION PROPOSAL OF THE GAS COMPANY TO THE ALTERNATIVE 4 INSTALLATION PROPOSAL OF A UTILITY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY CHOSEN BY 5 THE PROPERTY OWNERS.
- 6 (D) (1) IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROCEDURES THE COMMISSION
 7 ADOPTS BY REGULATION OR ORDER, THE GAS COMPANY SHALL ALLOW THE
 8 PROPERTY OWNERS TO SELECT BETWEEN INSTALLATION OF THE PROPOSED
 9 GAS SERVICE EXTENSION BY THE GAS COMPANY OR BY THE UTILITY
 10 CONSTRUCTION COMPANY.
- 11 (2) THE INSTALLATION OF A GAS SERVICE EXTENSION BY A
 12 UTILITY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL MEET OR
 13 EXCEED ALL APPLICABLE SAFETY AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS, INCLUDING
 14 ENGINEERING, QUALITY, AND INTERCONNECTION STANDARDS, THAT ARE
 15 REQUIRED FOR GAS PLANT THAT THE GAS COMPANY INSTALLS FOR ITS
 16 DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.
- 17 (3) A UTILITY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY THAT SUBMITS A
 18 PROPOSAL OR INSTALLS A GAS SERVICE EXTENSION UNDER THIS SECTION MUST
 19 BE APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION OR THE GAS COMPANY IN ACCORDANCE
 20 WITH PROCEDURES THE COMMISSION ADOPTS BY REGULATION OR ORDER.
- (E) (1) (I) ON THE COMPLETION OF THE GAS SERVICE EXTENSION, THE GAS MAINS, SERVICE LINES, AND OTHER GAS PLANT BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE GAS COMPANY ONCE THE PROPERTY OWNERS AND THE GAS COMPANY HAVE EXECUTED A GAS EXTENSION REBATE AGREEMENT IN A FORM THAT THE COMMISSION APPROVES.
- 26 (II) THE GAS EXTENSION REBATE AGREEMENT SHALL
 27 REQUIRE THE GAS COMPANY TO PAY TO THOSE PROPERTY OWNERS A
 28 PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE PROCEEDS THAT THE GAS COMPANY COLLECTS
 29 FROM OTHER PROPERTY OWNERS WHO SUBSEQUENTLY CONNECT TO THE GAS
 30 SERVICE EXTENSION THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT.
- **(2)** THE 31 PROPERTY **OWNERS** SHALL \mathbf{BE} **SUBJECT** TO 32 CONTRIBUTION FOR THE COST OF A GAS SERVICE EXTENSION INSTALLED BY A 33 UTILITY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IN THE SAME MANNER THAT THEY WOULD BE 34SUBJECT TO CONTRIBUTION FOR A GAS SERVICE EXTENSION INSTALLED BY THE 35 GAS COMPANY.

- 5 (F) EACH GAS COMPANY SHALL PUBLISH ON ITS WEB SITE AND BY
 6 OTHER APPROPRIATE MEANS A DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCEDURES FOR
 7 OBTAINING AND CONNECTING TO AN EXTENSION OF GAS MAINS, SERVICE LINES,
 8 AND OTHER GAS PLANT IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS THAT ARE IN THE SERVICE
 9 TERRITORY OF THE GAS COMPANY BUT ARE NOT CURRENTLY RECEIVING GAS
 10 SUPPLY FROM THE GAS COMPANY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
