1 AN ACT concerning

Procurement – Preferences – Businesses Located in the State
FOR the purpose of requiring a unit of State government to allow a resident bidder or resident offeror to resubmit the bid or offer, under certain circumstances, to match the lowest bid or offer; defining certain terms; and generally relating to preferences for businesses located in the State.
BY adding to
Article – State Finance and Procurement
Section 14–401.1 Annotated Code of Maryland
(2009 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article – State Finance and Procurement
14–401.1.
(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
(2) "RESIDENT BIDDER" MEANS A BIDDER WHOSE PRINCIPAL
OFFICE IS LOCATED IN THE STATE.
(3) "RESIDENT OFFEROR" MEANS AN OFFEROR WHOSE
PRINCIPAL OFFICE IS LOCATED IN THE STATE.
