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

1	AN ACT concerning
2	Harford County Board of Education – Student Member – Voting Rights
3 4 5 6 7	FOR the purpose of providing that the student member of the Harford County Board of Education has certain rights and privileges; prohibiting the student member from voting on or participating in certain matters; making certain clarifying changes; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to the Harford County Board of Education and student member voting rights.
8 9 10 11 12	BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 3–6A–01 and 3–6A–02 Annotated Code of Maryland (2008 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement)
13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
15	Article - Education
16	3–6A–01.
17 18 19	(a) (1) In this subtitle, "elected member" means a voting member elected under subsection (d) or (e) of this section or a member appointed to an elected position on the Harford County Board of Education under subsection (e)(2) of this section.
20	(2) "Elected member" does not include a:
21 22	(i) County superintendent of schools serving as an ex officion member of the county board; or





1 2	(ii) A voting ELECTED member OR AN APPOINTED MEMBER may not serve for more than two consecutive terms as a voting member.
3 4	(3) The Harford County Board of Elections may adopt regulations to implement this subsection.
5 6 7	(f) (1) The Harford County Council shall appoint a qualified individual to fill any vacancy of an elected member on the county board for the remainder of the term and until a successor is elected and qualifies.
8 9 10	(2) The Governor shall appoint a qualified individual to fill any vacancy of an appointed member of the county board for the remainder of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
11 12 13	(g) (1) The [nonvoting] student member of the county board shall be elected by the high school students of the county in accordance with procedures established by the Harford County public school system.
14	(2) The student member shall:
15 16	(i) Be an eleventh or twelfth grade student, in good standing, and regularly enrolled in the Harford County public school system;
17 18	(ii) Be a student government association representative at the student's high school;
19 20	(iii) Serve for 1 year beginning on July 1 after the election of the member;
21 22	(iv) [Be a nonvoting] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SECTION, BE A VOTING member; and
23 24	(v) Advise the county board on the thoughts and feelings of students in the Harford County public schools.
25 26 27 28	(3) (I) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE STUDENT MEMBER OF THE HARFORD COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION HAS THE SAME RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES AS A MEMBER APPOINTED OR ELECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.
29 30 31 32 33	(II) Unless invited to attend by an affirmative vote of a majority of the county board, the student member may not attend an executive session of the county board ADDRESSING A MATTER ON WHICH A STUDENT MEMBER IS PROHIBITED FROM VOTING ON UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

- (III) THE STUDENT MEMBER SHALL 1 VOTE ON AND 2 PARTICIPATE IN ALL MATTERS EXCEPT THOSE RELATING TO: 3 1. GEOGRAPHICAL ATTENDANCE AREAS UNDER § 4–109 OF THIS ARTICLE; 4 2. 5 6	(a) [The] EXCEPT FOR THE STUDENT MEMBER, THE State Board may remove a voting member of the county board for:
7	(1) Immorality;
8	(2) Misconduct in office;
9	(3) Incompetency;
10	(4) Willful neglect of duty; or
$\frac{1}{2}$	(5) Failure to attend, without good cause, at least 75% of the scheduled meetings of the county board in any 1 calendar year.
13 14 15	(b) Before removing a member, the State Board shall send the member a copy of the charges and give the member an opportunity to request a hearing within 10 days.
16	(c) If the member requests a hearing within the 10-day period:
17 18 19	(1) The State Board promptly shall hold a hearing, but a hearing may not be set within 10 days after the State Board sends the member a notice of the hearing; and
20 21	(2) The member shall have an opportunity to be heard publicly before the State Board in the member's own defense, in person or by counsel.
22 23	(d) A member removed under this section has the right to a de novo review of the removal by the Circuit Court for Harford County.
24 25	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1 2012
