CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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Harford County Board of Education – Student Member – Voting Rights

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the student member of the Harford County Board 4 of Education has certain rights and privileges; prohibiting the student member 5 from voting on or participating in certain matters; providing that certain 6 provisions of law relating to the payment of certain expenses for members of the 7 Harford County Board of Education do not apply to the student member of the 8 Board; making certain clarifying changes; altering a certain definition; and 9 generally relating to the Harford County Board of Education and student 10 member voting rights and expense allowance.
